

OVERNIGHT VOLUNTEER GUIDELINES

- You must be an oasis approved-<https://volunteer.osceola.k12.fl.us/>
- You must have fingerprinting done @ district office

- Chaperones must dress appropriately
- Please make sure you have a contact number for the teacher
- Follow the timeline and itinerary given by the teacher.
- Must accompany students to the pool area. (If applicable)
 - please insist students travel in groups of 3 or more at all times
- Absolutely no smoking, tobacco products or alcohol at any time in the presence of student.
- Do not use profane or inappropriate language.
- Do not buy drinks, snacks (due to food allergies) or souvenirs for the group unless it has been planned as part of the trip.
- Please limit the use of cell phones to emergency only.
 - You are there for the students
- Please refer discipline issues to the teacher (use your better judgment).
- Report any bullying issues to the teacher.
 - Please try to handle any situation before disturbing the Directors if possible
- Student room checks will be scheduled by the Director/Teacher in charge
 - Please do not enter the room of a student of the opposite sex at any time unless a medical emergency. Even if your student/child is sharing that room.
- Do not take off with any student without Directors knowledge
- Please keep in mind this is not a vacation. Please do not have family members with you during your volunteering time. You are there to supervise all students.
