

School Times

- (M-T-TH-F) 8:20am 3:20pm
- 8:20am-2:20pm (Wednesday)
- Early parent pick up (20 minutes prior to dismissal).

Morning Procedures

All students are searched and scanned/wanded upon arrival to campus.

New Student Enrollment Fee

 Upon enrollment, students must pay a fee of \$20 to cover the cost of school supplies, classroom materials, etc.

School Rules

- Confiscated Items -

- Students are not allowed to bring <u>ANY personal items</u> with them to school (<u>NO EXCEPTION</u>).
 - This includes, but is not limited to: <u>CELL PHONES</u> (parent must pick up between (9am-3:00pm), wallets, bags, makeup, chap stick, lip gloss, gum/candy, drinks, necklaces, bracelets, watches, anklets etc.
 - Items not picked up at the end of the year are donated or discarded.

Student Monitoring

Transition

Transition Requirements

- Reason for placement at New Beginnings/District Directive
- Embracing 4 A's (Attendance, Achievement, Attitude, Accountability)
- Exit Letter from Principal
- Minimum of one semester OR up to two school years.
- Transitions occur mid-year (December) and at the end of the school year (May).

Dress Code Policy

Uniform

- All students must follow NBEC Dress Code Policy (Next Slide).
- Uniform Polos may be purchased at the school for \$15.

School ID Card

- ID Cards must be visibly worn at all times.
- Must be replaced, if lost or damaged, at a cost of \$5.00.

Violating Dress Code

Disciplinary action given to students in constant violation of the dress code. (work detail, lunch detention, ISS)

Dress Code Policy continued...

Students must wear a <u>light blue polo</u> at all times.

- Students must wear ALL BLACK JOGGER pants (cotton) ONLY. NO metal (zippers, buttons etc.) are permitted anywhere on the pants.
- Solid black or white undershirts (long or short sleeve) may be worn underneath uniform polo.
- All students must wear slip on shoes. Shoes must have a back and <u>must be either black or white</u>. NO shoelaces, buckles or Velcro allowed. Socks must also be black or white.
- Nail Colors must be neutral (i.e., light pinks, nudes, white, light grey) and <u>CANNOT</u> be excessively long and <u>NO extra jewelry attached to nails.</u>
- Hair Cut, Color, and Styles must be natural/clean cut. (<u>NO</u> carvings or designs). <u>Hair can not exceed past the bra line/mid back.</u>
- NO JEWELRY may be worn except for up to TWO PAIRS of earrings (no bigger than a quarter) and a stud-style OR hoop nose ring, if applicable.
 - **Should a belly-button ring be worn, and search wand beeps, student will be subject to a full search.** Clear piercing must put in place of metal piercing if anywhere else on your body
- Jackets/Sweatshirts are permitted to wear <u>TO school NOT in school</u>. <u>Hoods are NOT permitted</u>. Acceptable colors are white, navy blue or black ONLY!
