TREASURER'S REPORT – *Teia Hooper*

- Our current balances provided from our bookkeeper are \$18,821 in one account and \$171.19 in the smaller account
- \$2,500 paid to Jannine Martino for PBIS

- The Athletic Department does raise its own funds, but there was debate over specifically what they fund
- There was also debate over whether the bowling equipment supported the SIP (tabled discussion until Carl follows up)

FUNDS REQUESTS

- Coach D on behalf of the PE Department requested \$2890 for 10 new bowling equipment sets. Debate was held over whether SAC should fund PE's request for new bowling equipment based on whether the request was able to support the SIP. Christy Flanagan-Feddon called a vote and the result was 8 yay, 4 nay, 2 no vote. The vote/approval was held pending guidance from Dr. Straker.

OPEN FORUM

- District will try to revise budget to include water bottle filling stations so PTA/SAC will not have to fund
- Questions regarding Wellness Wednesday- Dr. McMahon stated there is no formal wellness program but the school does have mental health lessons taught monthly
- Honor Roll certificates are being reprinted
- Request to review previous SAC expenditures
