SAFTEY REPORT – *Mr. Weeden on behalf of Deputy Plaza*

- Scooters are a rising safety concern.
- Greg Filak notified members of a community wide meeting next week to discuss the scooters, helmets, etc
- Debi Wisneski voiced a concern about parents parking in the fire lane when picking up students for early dismissal
- Debi Wisneski and Teia Hooper voiced concerns over teachers parking on the streets instead of behind the gym

SIP– *Mr. Weeden*

- Mr. Weeden presented the SIP
- Quick overview of data, CK8 surpassed the state on every assessment but has decreased since 2019/ post- COVID
- Area of Focus ESSA subgroup SWD (scored 38% vs 41% of total points possible on school grade calculation) and Chronically Absent Students (212)
- Goal is to bring subgroup score to 45% through assessing data and targeted interventions and decrease the number of chronically absent students by 25 students with a 3-Tier Approach
- Motion to approve SIP by Debi Wisneski, seconded by Tracey Perrault, passed unanimously.
