

# Creating an Official SAT Practice Account and Linking it to CollegeBoard

This document explains how to create a student Official SAT practice account on Khan Academy and successfully link with CollegeBoard to receive free personalized practice

**Step 1:** Visit [www.khanacademy.org/sat](http://www.khanacademy.org/sat)

**Step 2:** Click "Sign up"



**Step 3:** Select "learner," enter your date of birth, and select **SIGN UP WITH EMAIL**

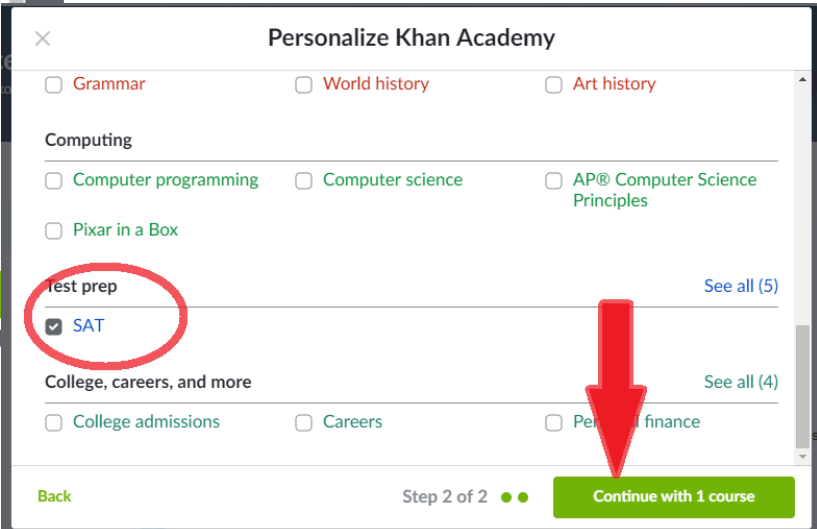
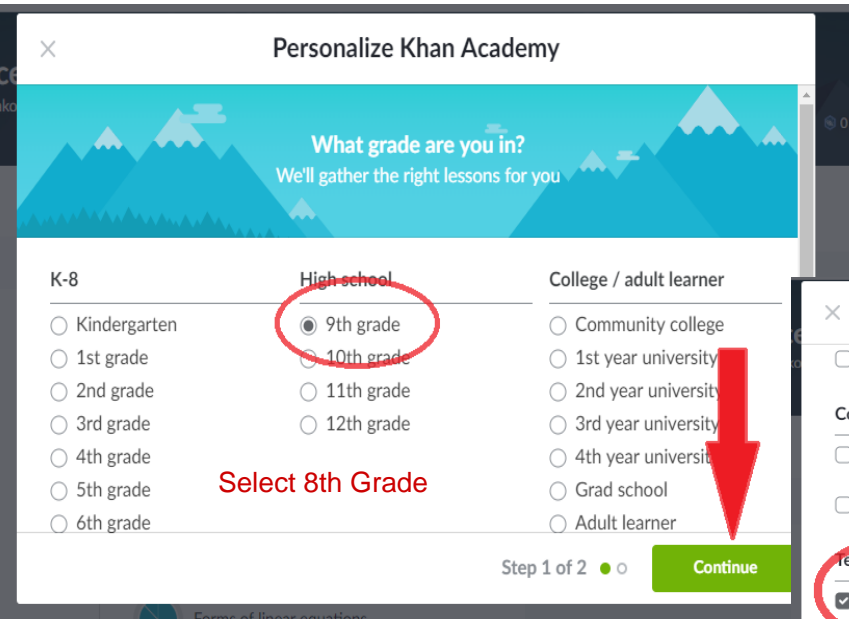

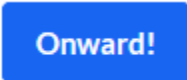
