6. To provide training opportunities and information for parents, parent groups, teachers, school staff, or community groups, which will empower parents to become active participants in their child's education.
7. To provide outreach and ensure parents of ELLs are informed and involved in their child's education.

**District ELL Parent Leadership Council Executive Board includes but not limited to the following positions:**

1. Chairperson
  - Shall coordinate the meetings with the support of the District's Bilingual Community Liaison.
  - Shall sign the ELL District plan of behalf of the ELL Parent Leadership Council Executive Board.
2. Co-chairperson
  - Shall partner with the chairperson to fulfill chairperson duties as training for future chairperson role.
3. Secretary
  - Shall maintain written records of all meetings on behalf of the ELL Parent Leadership Council Executive Board.
  - Shall be present to read minutes at the meetings.
4. Sub Committee Chair
  - Shall organize volunteers to serve in sub committees when special projects arise.
5. Immediate Past Chairperson
  - Shall act as a guide and advisor for the current chairperson.
