BUS INFORMATION

to check if your address is eligible for bus transportation. Bus routes and times will be available on the same website the week prior to school starting.

ARRIVAL TIME 7:50-8:20

Once students arrive on campus they may eat breakfast in the cafeteria or go directly to their classroom. Students must be present, in their seats, ready to learn, at 8:20 when the tardy bell rings and instruction begins.

CAR RIDERS

The car loop has two lanes. The left Lane is for PK-1 and their older siblings and the right Lane is for 2-5. The earliest students may arrive on campus will be 7:50AM. Please do not drop-off students before that time as there will be no supervision.

DO NOT attempt to drop-off in the parking lot or other locations. The School Resource Officer will require you to go back through the car line.

DISMISSAL TIME 3:20/WEDNESDAYS 2:20

Car Riders-Please write your child's first and last name on the provided dashboard tag with a broad tip black or blue marker prior to the end of the first day of school and place it on your dashboard or hang it from your rearview mirror. To protect the safety of our students, no student will be released in the car loop unless the car contains the designated car tag.

Walkers and Bike Riders-All parents picking up walker and bike rider students will be asked to wait outside the gate by the bike rack. The gate is closed and locked during the day except for arrival and dismissal times.

Any changes to student dismissal should be written in the student agenda.


