Dress Code Policy

- Students must adhere to the Osceola School District uniform policy.
- Students must wear either a navy, white, black, or yellow/gold polo Monday through Thursday
- College shirts can be worn on Thursdays when announced
- School spirit t-shirts can be worn on Fridays only

Student IDs

- ❖ All students will be provided with a student ID
- ❖ Students will use their IDs to obtain breakfast and lunch and to check out books from the library
- ❖ Students must wear their ID lanyard every day
- ❖ Students who arrive to school without their ID must report directly to the patio office (6th grade students must report to the 6th grade office)
- ❖ **Replacement IDs are \$5.00. Temporary IDs are \$1.00**
- ❖ **All student debts must be paid in order to participate in extracurricular activities**
- ❖ Student who continuously arrive without their ID will be given consequences

Tardy to School & Class

Timely arrival to class and to school is an important habit for students to develop and maintain. As such, the school will monitor your child's arrival to school and to class throughout the year. Parents are encouraged to follow your child's classroom attendance through parent portal. Speak with your child about the importance of being on time. The following guidelines for monitoring students' timely arrival to class are in place for the school year to ensure maximum instructional time.

- A student is tardy to school when he/she arrives to school after the late bell. School begins at 9:20 am
- **Students who are tardy to school will be assigned detention**
- Tardies to class will be tracked daily
- Being tardy 4 or more times in a marking period is considered excessive.
- Students will receive consequences for excessive tardies, and parents will be notified.

Student Laptops

All students will be provided with a student laptop. Students must charge their laptops every night and bring them to school every day. Students are responsible for the proper care of their assigned device. Students who forget their device at home will be assigned consequences.
