DRESS CODE POLICY



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Polos or button-up shirts must be solid black, white, purple, or dark/navy blue.



Red and gray ARE NOT among our school's approved shirt colors.



No hats or bandanas may be worn without administrator approval (district policy).

DRESS CODE POLICY

- Shorts and skirts must be appropriate length (mid-thigh).
- Pants, skirts, and shorts can be solid blue, black, or tan and can be denim or khaki.
- Exercise pants, yoga pants, sweatpants, and dance leggings **ARE NOT** within dress code.
