The Osceola County School Board knows that in the beginning of a new school year, parents and students have plenty of questions. Luckily, the answers are just a phone call or a click away!

As in all previous years, we would kindly request patience and understanding for the first few weeks of school as we iron out the details of our bus routes for another school year. New students always show up that we were not aware of and routes must be adjusted. While we do our best to honor the pick-up and drop-off times given, it is not atypical to have buses run 20-30 minutes late in the morning and afternoon routes as we get things rolling and ensure that the correct children are being safely transported to the correct location. Any buses that encounter an overcrowding situation will be adjusted by creating a new route or adding a second bus. Please plan accordingly for the first few weeks of school.
