Next step to guided reading is utilized to inform teachers of a child's reading level. This information is used to organize small group guided reading.

Baseline reading fluency assessment given once a year unless a student is Tier 2 or Tier 3, they receive the assessment multiple times a year.

ELA – Informational text and identifying plot structure, theme, and poetry
