CTE PATHWAY courses are a series of courses that you can earn certification in that field. **Your elective choices are NOT guaranteed. Courses offered may change.**

**Number 1-6 for the electives that you are interested in, 1 being the elective that you want the most.**

- 2-D Studio Art 1** (Overview of drawing, painting, and art history)
- AP Computer Science Principles** (must have passed Algebra 1; will learn central ideas of computer science)

- Acting** (for students serious about performing on stage)
- Technical Theater Design/Production** (support the theater program-construction/ lighting/sound)
- Spanish 1 or 2** (learn the basics of the Spanish language)
- Psychology 1 and 2** (Must be taken before AICE Psychology)
- Chorus** (learn to sing or advance your vocal abilities)
- Guitar** (learn to play the guitar no experience necessary)
- Band** (No experience required)
- Jazz Ensemble** (Class for advanced musicians) *\*must take Band concurrently\**
- Color Guard** (Flag Performance with Requirement of Marching Band; full year)
- Orchestra** (for all string instruments: violin, viola, cello, and double bass)
- AVID** (Focus on college readiness, organization, study skills) *\*must already be in AVID or accepted via application\**
- ROTC** (become a leader though ARMY leadership principles) *\*2 years of course waives PE and Fine art credit\**
- Personal Fitness/Comprehensive Fitness** (PE class required for graduation)
- Agriscience Foundation 1** (Introduction to Agricultural Industry) CTE PATHWAY COURSE
- Digital Video** (HD cameras and editing software) CTE PATHWAY COURSE
- Introduction to Engineering Design** (overview of the engineer field/use of computers and hands on activities)

- Principles of Entrepreneur** (overview of basic computer functions and computer programming)

- Criminal Justice 1** (prepare for further education and careers in Paralegal Law) CTE PATHWAY COURSE
- Game and Simulation Foundations** (use the history of Gaming to learn game concepts then create video games)

- Vet Assisting 1** (introduction to the animal industry and veterinary medicine) CTE PATHWAY COURSE
- Foundations of Journalism** (Develop fundamental skills through the writing process for varied journalistic media)

### Schedule Change Policy

1. **Valid reasons** for a schedule change may include: computer error, failing a required course, passing a course in summer school, lacking a graduation requirement and/or lacking the proper prerequisite.
2. Schedule change requests will **NOT** be considered for the purpose of teacher preference or period.
3. A change request may require the entire schedule to be altered to meet the request you have made, including different teachers and different class periods.
4. Electing an AP course, I understand it is taught at a college level and once chosen will not be able to receive a schedule change without **proof of content struggle and success meeting with teacher and administration. Please Initial \_\_\_\_\_**
5. All schedule change requests must be approved by the Principal, Assistant Principal, and Counselor.

I have read and understand the schedule change policy and am aware that **I have until May 16, 2025 to change my course requests.** I, also, understand that if I choose an Advanced Placement (AP) course that it is at a college level and once scheduled into the course during the 25-26 school year that I will not be able to have a schedule change out of this class.
