

# St. Cloud High School Prom Guidelines

## General Guidelines:



- 🐾 To be able to purchase prom tickets students must:
  - ✓ Have **NO Obligations** (i.e., money or books)
  - ✓ No major discipline issues for 2<sup>nd</sup> semester
    - **No more than 2 days ISS and NO OSS**
- 🐾 If you are having a guest attend prom with you – you must:
  - ✓ Turn in your guest form to Ms. Neglia by April 20<sup>th</sup> (NO EXCEPTIONS)
- 🐾 If you leave prom, you may not return. **All exits are FINAL**
- 🐾 No “moshing” or “mosh pits” are permitted
- 🐾 All other school board policies apply. **NO** tobacco products, drugs or alcohol will be tolerated. Anyone under the influence of drugs or alcohol will be removed from prom and will face disciplinary consequences. **NO REFUNDS** will be granted.

**Violations of these policies will result in dismissal from the prom, possible law enforcement involvement and no refunds will be granted.**

# St. Cloud High School Prom Dress Code

## Formal Attire:

- ✓ Dress pants
- ✓ Dress shirt/tie
- ✓ Dress shoes
- ✓ Dresses and skirts
  - 🐾 Length can range from fingertip (mid-thigh) to floor length, measured from the shortest point.
  - 🐾 Slits must not extend above fingertip length
  - 🐾 Strapless or spaghetti strap dress or top **MAY NOT** have excessive cleavage showing. (.5' maximum)
  - 🐾 **NO** plunging neck and back lines (i.e., low cut fronts and backs)
  - 🐾 Wear correct undergarments for your dress
  - 🐾 Two-piece dresses may not have more than 1 inch of mid-drift showing.
  - 🐾 You may carry a small handbag or clutch ONLY

### **DO NOT WEAR:**

- ⊗ Blue jeans or pants with holes/rips/tears
- ⊗ Tennis shoes, sneakers, casual sandals/beach flip-flops
- ⊗ Baseball hats or any other headgear
- ⊗ Pants worn below waist with underwear showing

**Anyone out of compliance with the dress code will be denied entrance and NO REFUNDS will be given.**
