# SAC Meeting Minutes-February 25th, 2025

## MEETING OVERVIEW

### **Approve January Meetings**

Discuss/approve 2025/26 Parent and Family Engagement Plan (PFEP), 2025/26 Compact, and Comprehensive Needs Assessment suvey

ParentInvolmentMeetings Reviewed handout regarding meetings for next year. Discussion centered on the need for a parent information session to clarify testing processes (F.A.S.T.), how to use parent portal The sessions should differentiate between individual child assessments and general scoring criteria to minimize confusion. Suggestions included scheduling these sessions on different nights to cater to various grade levels, particularly for K-2 students, ensuring parents are well-prepared before engaging with teachers about their children's performance. Planning for virtual meetings during the summer to prepare for new school year, well as highlighting short video tutorials on how to use online tools.

# **Updates on Club 42 & Upcoming Testing**

Updates on Club 42 were provided, focusing on supporting students who scored at levels one and two through increased one-on-one tutoring. The program currently serves 24 students with a two-to-one tutor ratio, fostering connections between older and younger students. The group also discussed upcoming assessments for various grade levels and the importance of clear communication with parents regarding student performance reports.

Middle School Transition for 5th graders and families - Various ideas were proposed based on the need to prepare our 5th graders for Middle School including guest speakers who have experience teaching Middle School.

#### Strategies for Reducing Test Stress and Enhancing Parent Involvement

The team discussed ways to reduce test-related stress for students, such as organizing pep rallies and involving parents through supportive notes. There was also an emphasis on fostering a community that celebrates student achievements and enhances parent involvement to improve student outcomes.

#### **Funding Requests**

Council approved funding for \$300 for NEHS initiation ceremonies.

Proposed request for funding for author Peter Raymundo, who will visit the school to conduct age-appropriate storytelling and drawing sessions. The plan includes a week-long series of activities, competitions, and a celebration to encourage reading among students. Collaboration with Ms. Tavares is planned to integrate the event with existing literacy programs and address students' struggles with nonfiction reading.
