

KEYWORD THEMES Top Themes by total thoughts









Additionally, the center is partnering with Valencia and OTech to provide tuition-free college, which is especially important for those living below the poverty level in Osceola County. The responses to the question suggest that implementing a no phone zone in schools would be beneficial. It would improve teacher time, encourage live communication, and interactive learning. 
