Prom Dance Dress Code

<u>Females</u>

- Slits on dresses must not be above the top of the knee.
- Dresses must be mid-thigh.
- No cutouts on dresses, no mid-riff showing, no dresses that expose sides.
- No flip-flops
- Spaghetti straps and strapless dresses are acceptable.
- Dresses with back open to waist or lower are not permitted.
- No see-through dresses or suits

<u>Males</u>

- Dress shirts, tie, dress pants and belts are required (sport coat, suits, or tuxedos are optional)
- Tennis shoes and flip flops are not permitted.
- Jeans and/or golf shirts are not permitted.
- No bandanas, hats, headbands, etc., of any type are allowed.

The principal or principal's designee has the final authority for interpreting whether a student's apparel conforms to the dress code.

Dance Code: All activities throughout the evening will reflect appropriate and tasteful behavior. Any dancing showing explicit PDA behavior will result in removal from the Prom without a refund. Guests that are not CHS students will need to have this form signed by the CHS student's parents and are subject to all school rules. No non-CHS student under 15 or over 20 will be admitted. This includes spouses of CHS students that are over 20 years of age. If you leave the dance, you will not be readmitted.
