### Digital Learning Information

We wanted to make sure that you were aware of some of the expectations for the coming school year. Students and parents will be able to access schedules in FOCUS starting on August 17, 2020. You can log in to FOCUS through Classlink on our website <https://www.osceolaschools.net/ochs> anytime.

1. All students will use their Student ID# as their username for log in to ClassLink and/or all school computers.
2. If you are a returning student, your password is the same as last year; unless you received a new laptop for fall semester, then your password will be the one indicated when you picked-up your laptop.
3. If you are a new student from another district, you will need to set your password by calling the District Help Desk at 407-870-4000.
4. ### Digital Expectations/TEAMS

Unlike in the 4<sup>th</sup> quarter of the 2019-2020 school year, the format of digital learning will be much different. Students will be required to follow their schedule by class period. If you have a 1<sup>st</sup> period class that starts at 7:20am, you are required to log into that class. Attendance will be taken for every class period, it is the responsibility of the student to make sure they log in and stay logged in the entire period. Failure to do so could result in your removal from digital learning. All assignments will be delivered to students through TEAMS and it is the expectation that all assignments are submitted through TEAMS. Teacher lesson plans have been revamped since the spring to be better formatted for digital learning. Below is a list of general behavior expectations. Teachers will provide you with their specific expectations when you begin class. Failure to comply with the behavior expectations will result in disciplinary action.

### Off Campus Period

Due to a variety of reasons it may have been necessary for you to receive an Off Campus period even though you are not on campus to leave. During this period, you will not need to log into a TEAMS class. It is a scheduled break. Make sure that you log back into your next class period after your off campus period. Attendance is being taken for each digital course. Will this hurt you due to credits needed? No, 24 credits are required for graduation and having 1-2 period(s) off will still allow you achieve the required number of credits in four years.

### Changing Learning Options

If you are digital student and wish make a change to face to face you will be required to wait until September 8, 2020 to make the request for that change. There could be up to a one week waiting period before the change can take place. Students coming to school will be required to follow all policies and procedures regarding COVID-19 safety, including social distancing and wearing a mask at all times while on campus (excluding lunch).
