- This is an easy and free way for your child to practice reading.
- Encourage your child to find books that they are interested in. This will help grow their desire to read on their own.



What parents can do to help at home

- Hold a conversation and discuss what your child has read. Ask your child probing questions
 about the book and connect the events to his or her own life. For example, say "I wonder
 why that girl did that?" or "How do you think he felt? Why?" and "So, what lesson can we
 learn here?".
- Help your child make connections between what he or she reads and similar experiences
 he has felt, saw in a movie, or read in another book.
- Help your child monitor his or her understanding. Teach her to continually ask herself whether she understands what she's reading.
- Help your child go back to the text to support his or her answers.
- Discuss the meanings of unknown words, both those he reads and those he hears.
- Read material in short sections, making sure your child understands each step of the way.
- Discuss what your child has learned from reading informational text such as a science or social studies book.
