What are the critical needs and challenges of Osceola County Public Schools that that the next superintendent will need to understand and address.

- 1. Overall staffing shortages and wages
- 2. Prioritize students through class size, education and safety
- 3. Address struggling students' needs
- 4. Explosive growth monitor out of county and choice. Example 42 students with two teachers in a classroom and 10 were out of county (Celebration K-8)
- 5. Treat all students equally
- 6. New programs with small class sizes take up full size classrooms
- 7. Address teachers burn out and loss of teachers
- 8. Review out of zone transfer requests annually
- 9. Student behavior and discipline system wide/ teachers hands are tied with little or no options except to call parents who are often not responsive or helpful
- 10. More teachers and parents needed on the discipline committee
